About Project Unnati

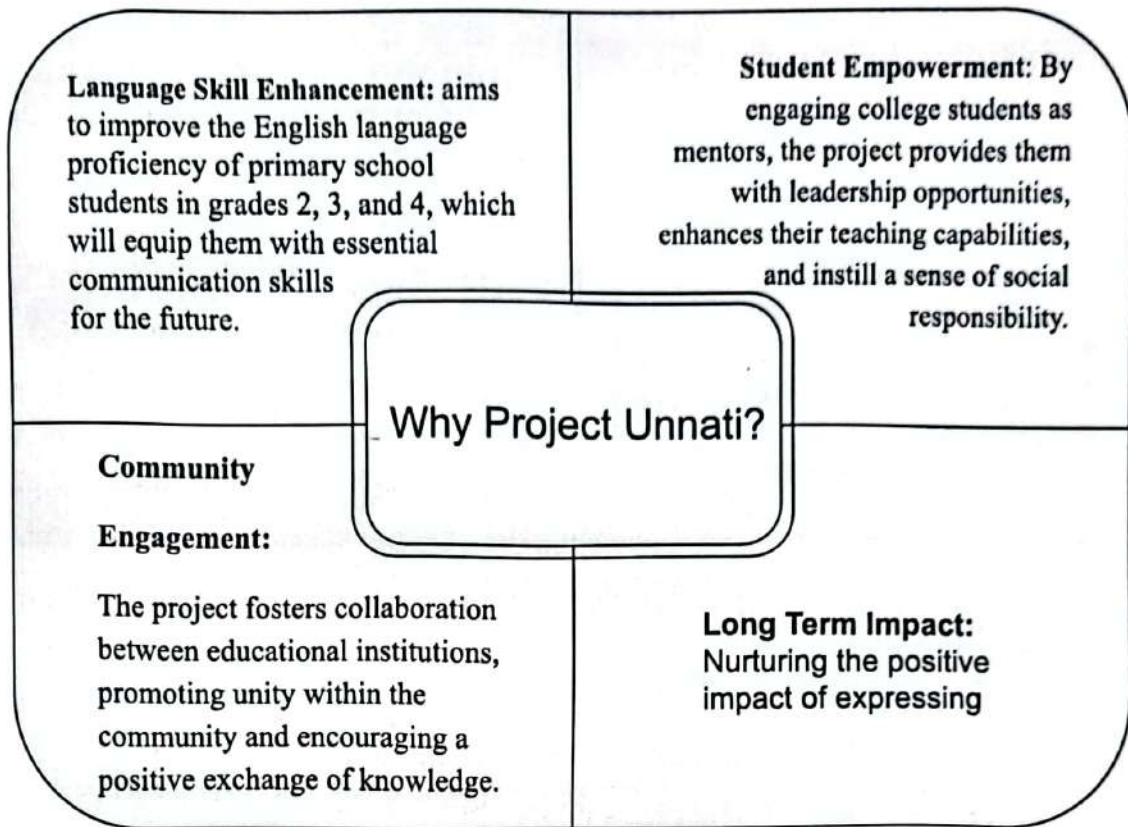

As a part of the activity, students will be going to the school adopted by the University twice a week for a consecutive period of three months.
